[SELFIE](#) (Self-reflection on Effective Learning by Fostering the use of Innovative Educational technologies) is a customisable tool that helps schools to reflect where they stand with the use of digital technologies for teaching and learning in the digital age. SELFIE was launched in 2018 with the aim to support schools to develop their digital strategy involving the school community (school leaders, teachers and students). After almost 3 years, it has gathered **1.7 million users** from 82 countries. On October 7th and 8th we want to bring the SELFIE community together in the second SELFIE Forum which will take place online.

A part of the Forum will focus on providing ideas and inspiration for schools to create their own action plan and take a step forward in terms of their digital empowerment. We strongly believe that the participation of schools that have already used SELFIE would be of great importance, as they can support others by sharing their overall experience and proposing good practices.

Schools are invited to participate by submitting a **poster** or a **short video** of up to 3 minutes focused on a very specific topic which will portray the school experience with SELFIE, but it will also provide useful information to other schools to develop their digital strategy and action plan. The Posters and Videos will be exhibited online and will be shared with all Forum participants. **After the Forum**, we will select a limited number from the submitted contributions and ask the contributors to develop them in a short text to be included in a JRC edited publication (it is expected to be completed in a time frame of 6-12 months).

USEFUL INFORMATION

Your contributions will appear on the Forum website and will be available online.

Selected submissions will be invited to be included in a JRC edited publication which will follow the forum and will be completed within a time frame of 6-12 months.

Language: **English.**

In case of video submissions, you can use national languages, but it will be necessary to add subtitles in English.

Submission Format:

- **Posters** (in pdf form) created with any software most accessible to the schools. There is an option for interested schools to use e-posters (<https://tb.io/eposters/>). For this purpose schools may contact us JRC-EAC-SELFIEFORUM@ec.europa.eu to give you access to the e-posters.
- **Videos:** No longer than 3 minutes.
- **Images, animations, drawings for students:** no specific format requirements.

Deadline for Submissions: **2nd October 2021.**

Updates about how and where to submit your contributions will follow at the beginning of September 2021.
